

BSS School Uniform

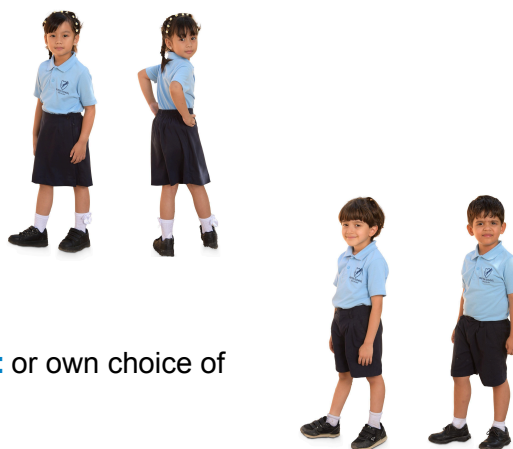

Girls & Boys School Uniform

FS1 & FS2 Boys & Girls

- Navy knee length shorts +
- Blue short sleeved BSS Polo Shirt +
- Hoodie BSS logo only +
- Socks - black or white only
- Shoes - full black footwear
- Sun Hat - to be worn outside only (BSS + or own choice of hat)
- BSS library bag +

Girls School Uniform

Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 Girls

- Navy knee length skirt (+)
- White short sleeved BSS Shirt +
- Hoodie - BSS logo only +
- Socks or tights - black or white only
- Shoes - full black footwear
- Sun Hat - to be worn outside only (BSS + or own choice of hat)
- BSS library bag +



Year 6 & Senior School Girls - Year 6 to 11

- Navy knee length, pleated skirt (‡) or navy full length tailored trousers
- White short or long sleeved BSS Shirt ‡
- Hoodie - BSS logo only ‡
- Socks - black or white only
- Shoes - full black footwear
- Sun Hat - to be worn outside only (BSS ‡ or own choice of hat)

Boys School Uniform

Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 Boys

- Navy knee length shorts (‡) or Charcoal or black full length tailored trousers
- White short or long sleeved BSS Shirt ‡
- Hoodie - BSS logo only ‡
- Socks - black or white only
- Shoes - full black footwear*
- Sun Hat - to be worn outside only (BSS ‡ or own choice of hat)
- BSS library bag ‡



Footwear

- Footwear with uniform should be completely black with no heel, no open toe or open back.
- Any logo or sole should also be completely black.
- The footwear should be a shoe or trainer and not a boot.
- Trainers may be worn with PE kit

Jewellery

- **Primary** - Jewellery permitted - 1 watch, 1 pair of stud earrings
- **Senior** - Jewellery permitted - 1 watch, 1 necklace (small and discreet), 1 pair of stud earrings, 1 signet ring
- Religious jewellery and adornments - any family wishing a child to wear such items should submit a written request to the Head of School in advance of the item being worn. This request will then be reviewed and a written response will be given to the family regarding the School's decision.
- **PE for Primary** - if your child is unable to remove their own earrings from their ear lobe, then they must come to school with plasters over their earrings.
- **PE for Senior** - all jewellery needs to be removed

Make-Up

- **Primary** - no make-up to be worn
- **Senior** - Make-up, if worn, should be subtle, minimalistic and natural.
- Nail varnish is not permitted

Hair

- **Primary** - Hair must be tidy and long hair tied back at all times.
- **Senior** - Hair must be tidy and long hair tied back for practical subjects such as PE, Science practical, DT and Art.
- Hair styles and colour should not be extreme. Hair styles and hair colour should not be a distraction to learning.
- All hair accessories should be modest and not distract from learning.
- Blue, black or white religious head coverings can be worn.

Other

- Clearly label all belongings with your child's name, including hats and bags.
- If a skirt, skort or shorts is not knee length, then trousers should be worn. [See trouser guide here.](#)
- Leggings should not be worn beneath skirts, skorts or shorts - trousers should be worn instead - exception is when the child is doing PE.
- During any fancy dress days, clothes should be culturally appropriate.
- Any student returning to BSS as a visitor, should also be wearing culturally appropriate clothing.

PE Uniform

PE kit is worn by students in Y1 to Y11.

- PE Sports Shirt (house colour) ‡
- PE shorts with BSS logo ‡
- White sports socks
- Trainers
- Sun hat, water bottle and sun cream
- Black leggings can be worn under shorts to cover the legs - in PE only
- Plain navy blue jogging bottoms can be worn. These should not be figure hugging and should have no patterns, stripes or coloured logos on them



FS1 & 2 wear their usual uniform for Physical Development activities

Sixth Form are not required to wear BSS PE kit but must wear suitable sports clothing and footwear.

New students should wear a plain coloured t-shirt for PE until they are allocated a house colour.
